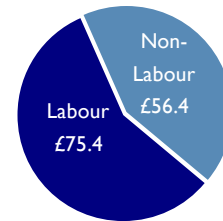


## Hopwood Hall College Stimulates Economic Growth

*Regional Growth Due to Hopwood Hall College*

(amounts in millions)

- Hopwood Hall College’s past and present activities account for £75.4 million in labour income (i.e., salaries) and £56.4 million in non-labour income (i.e., dividends, interest, and rent) in the region’s current economy.
- Altogether, the Greater Manchester economy receives roughly £131.8 million in added income due to the annual operations of Hopwood Hall College and the cumulative effects of its past and present learners.



## Hopwood Hall College Raises Consumer Spending

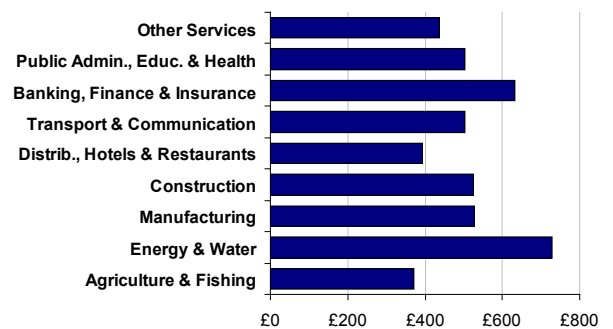


- Hopwood Hall College employed 469 staff during Financial Year 2008-09, with an annual payroll of £14.8 million.
- Hopwood Hall College spent a total of £24.3 million during the analysis year, including purchases of supplies and services.
- Approximately 23% of Hopwood Hall College’s learners either commuted or relocated to Greater Manchester from outside the region. These learners generated an estimated £11.7 million in sales while attending college.

## Hopwood Hall College Creates a Skilled Workforce

- Hopwood Hall College activities encourage new business, assist existing business, and create long-term economic growth. The college enhances worker skills and provides training opportunities to local business and industry.
- It is estimated that the present-day Greater Manchester workforce embodies approximately 65,000 qualifications gained by past and present Hopwood Hall College learners. These added skills promote business productivity and increase regional income.
