



The dovetail joint, used so frequently now, dates back to ancient Egypt.
 Furniture with dovetail has been found in the tombs of mummies of the first dynasty. This joint is present in the tombs of the classical Chinese emperors. These joints are known for their resilience and can be used to join pieces of furniture without any mechanical fasteners



- Timber is a wood or a tree grown specifically for carpentry and construction. It is carbon-negative so it's eco-friendly. Over 70% of the world's population lives in timber housing
- Hardwood and softwood contrary to their names, are the seeds, leaves
 and structure of the tree and not the type of wood. If you apply wood
 finishes to softwood, you'd be amazed at the results. The pine furniture
 book of the early 80's to late 90's was due to softwood popularity only.
- 80% of the world's timber production is accounted for by softwoods
